

Al Shaqab International Arabian Horse Show (ECAHO B' Intl Show)

Conditions of Entry: Open to horses registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entries.

Entry restrictions:

- World Championship, Title Show, A Show or GCAT Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a B show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior or from junior to a senior category.
- Gold medal winners in two B International Shows in the same year are not allowed to take part in a B International Show for the rest of that calendar year.
- Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified. The Owner must verify the horse's qualifications before registering it for the show.

Hereditary Disorders

Overbite/underbite:

- The Hereditary disorders declaration should be submitted along with the entries for each horse.
- Overbite/underbite Overbite/underbite of more than depth of 1 tooth is not permitted.
- Horses 12 months old and older cannot compete unless they have a veterinary certificate to verify that they do not have overbite/underbite.

Cryptorchidism:

- Colts 24 months old and older or stallions cannot compete unless they have a veterinary certificate to verify that they do not have cryptorchidism. If the colt's condition changes, and upon a completed veterinary certificate, the horse is then eligible to compete.

The DC / VET has the right to inspect the horse in case of any concerns.

Anybody submitting an incorrect declaration not corresponding to the true condition of the horse will receive a fine of 500€. The original of the declaration of such horse will be kept by the DC.



Note:

- Organizer has the right to accept or reject the entries and to restrict the number of participations per Owner.
- Organizer has the right to limit the number of entries for the show.
- The registration fees are non-refundable under any circumstances, including if the horse is withdrawn, canceled, or disqualified.
